



SEASONAL FORECAST FOR JUNE-JULY-AUGUST (JJA) 2025 SEASON N°70.

Rwanda Meteorology Agency (METEO RWANDA) is pleased to inform the Public that the dry-season for June-July-August (JJA) 2025 is expected to feature the country's normal average conditions. The maximum temperature across the country is predicted to range between 20°C and 30°C while the minimum temperature is predicted to be between 8°C and 16°C.

TEMPERATURE EXPECTED DURING JUNE-JULY-AUGUST 2025 SEASON

Maximum temperature expected in different parts of the country will be as follows:

During June-July-August 2025 season, daytime maximum temperatures across the country are expected to range between 20°C and 30°C.

- ❖ Maximum Temperature ranging between 28°C to 30°C: Is expected in the parts of Bugarama plain in Rusizi District and the parts of Eastern Province bordering Tanzania, especially Kirehe, Kayonza, Gatsibo and Nyagatare Districts.
- ❖ Maximum Temperature ranging between 26°C and 28°C: Is expected in the remaining parts of the Eastern Province, the City of Kigali, southern parts of Gicumbi, Huye, Nyaruguru and Nyamasheke Districts, eastern parts of Kamonyi and Ruhango Districts, the western parts of Rusizi District and most parts of Gisagara District.
- ❖ Maximum Temperatures ranging between 24°C and 26°C: Is expected in the remaining parts of Southern Province, except in Nyamagabe District, Western Province excluding Nyabihu District and northern parts of Rubavu District. Similarly, temperatures are also expected in the southern parts of Gakenke and Rulindo Districts, central parts of Gicumbi District, as well as western parts of Gatsibo and Nyagatare Districts.
- ❖ Maximum Temperatures ranging between 22°C and 24°C: Is expected in Nyabihu and Nyamagabe Districts, northern parts of Rubavu, Gakenke, Rulindo, and Gicumbi Districts, north-east and southern parts of Burera District, as well as southern parts of Musanze District.



❖ Maximum Temperatures ranging between 20°C and 22°C: Is expected in the remaining parts of Burera and Musanze Districts.

Minimum temperature expected in different parts of the country will be as follows:

- ❖ Minimum Temperature ranging between 8°C and 10°C: Is expected in western parts of Musanze District and a small portion of northern parts of Nyabihu District.
- ❖ Minimum Temperature ranging between 10°C and 12°C: Is predicted in most parts of Burera and Nyabihu Districts, northern parts of Gakenke and Rubavu Districts, southern parts of Nyamagabe District and remaining parts of Musanze District.
- ❖ Temperature ranging between 12°C and 14°C: Is expected in the remaining parts of Southern Province except eastern parts of Kamonyi District, Northern Province except eastern parts of Gicumbi and Rulindo Districts, western Province except western parts of



Rusizi and Nyamasheke Districts as well as in western parts of Nyagatare, Gatsibo and Bugesera Districts.

❖ Temperature ranging between 14°C and 16°C: Is predicted in the remaining parts of Eastern Province, City of Kigali, southern parts of Gicumbi and Rulindo Districts, eastern parts of Kamonyi, western parts of Rusizi, and Nyamasheke Districts.

EXPECTED RAINFALL DURING JUNE-JULY-AUGUST 2025 SEASON

The forecasted seasonal rains for June-July-August (JJA) 2025 will range between 15 to 150 mm which is in the range of the Long Term Mean of JJA season. The key factor that will influence rains during JJA 2025 season is associated with oscillation of Inter Tropical Convergence Zones (ITCZ). The global sea-surface temperatures are expected to remain close






to neutral conditions throughout the season.

Rainfall expected in the different parts of the country as follows:

- ❖ Rainfall ranging between 105-150 millimeters: Is expected in the most parts of Rubavu and Musanze Districts, as well as the northern parts of Nyabihu and Burera Districts.
- ❖ Rainfall ranging between 60-105 millimeters: Is expected in the remaining parts of Western Province, remaining parts of Burera and Musanze Districts, most parts of Gakenke District, western parts of Nyaruguru and Nyamagabe Districts, northern portion of Muhanga, Rulindo, and Gicumbi Districts.
- ❖ Rainfall ranging between 15-60 millimeters: Is expected in the Eastern Province, the City of Kigali and the remaining parts of northern and southern Provinces.
