Rainfall forecast from 1st to 10th August 2020

Rainfall Expected from 1st to 10th August 2020 (dekad 1 of August) ranges between 0 and 20mm countrywide. Rain ranging between 10 and 20mm is expected in mountainous area of Volcanoes in the districts of Rubavu, Nyabihu, Musanze, and Burera, in northern part of Nyagatare district and in Southern part of Nyaruguru district. The most parts of Western province and the rest of Musanze, Burera and Nyagatare districts are expected to receive rainfall ranging between 5 and 10mm. The remaining parts of the country will receive rainfall ranging between 0 and 5mm whereas most part of South Eastern province, Kigali and Southern province are expected to receive rainfall less than one (1) millimetre (see more details on map below).

The rainfall is expected toward the end of the dekad and rainy days will remain less than two in most parts of the country. The rainfall during the 1st dekad of August 2020 ranges in the normal of the Long Term Average rainfall of dekad 1 of August across the country.
