



**Weather forecast valid between 1<sup>st</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> July 2025**

**1. Summary:** During the first dekad of July 2025 (1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>), dry weather conditions with sunny intervals during daytime are expected. The daytime maximum temperatures will range between 18°C and 30°C, while nighttime minimum temperature is expected to range between 6°C and 16°C. The expected maximum temperature is within the range of Long-Term Mean (LTM) over many parts of the country while minimum temperature is slightly below the LTM of the first dekad of July. The LTM of maximum temperature ranges between 18°C and 30°C while the minimum temperature LTM ranges between 6°C and 17°C. Dry weather conditions with scattered rain is expected. Rainfall is expected to range between 0 and 15mm towards the end of this dekad. The expected rainfall will be within the range of LTM. In addition, moderate to strong winds, ranging from 4 m/s to 10 m/s, are expected across the country.

**2. Temperature forecast:**

- **Maximum Temperature:** During the first dekad of July 2025, the maximum temperature is expected to range between 18°C and 30°C across the country. Parts of Bugarama valley, many parts of Bugesera and Nyagatare Districts, eastern parts of Gatsibo and Kayonza Districts as well as western parts of Ngoma District are expected to record the highest maximum temperature ranging between 28°C and 30°C. Amayaga, Many parts of Kigali City and Rwamagana District, central parts of Ngoma, Kayonza, Gatsibo and Nyagatare Districts, northern and southern parts of Kirehe District as well as central parts of Rusizi District are expected to experience maximum temperature ranging between 26°C and 28°C. Eastern parts of Rubavu and Rutsiro Districts, many parts of Nyabihu District, western parts of Ngororero District and north-western parts of Musanze District are expected to experience lower maximum temperatures ranging between 18°C and 20°C.
- **Minimum Temperature:** The minimum temperature during nights is expected to range between 6°C and 16°C. Many parts of Nyabihu District, western parts of Musanze, Ngororero, Nyamagabe and Nyaruguru Districts as well as eastern parts of Rusizi District are expected to experience lowest minimum temperature ranging between 6°C and 8°C. A small portion of Nyagatare, Gatsibo, and Kayonza Districts, as well as Kigali City, is expected to experience relatively high minimum temperatures ranging from 14°C to 16°C.

**3. Rainfall forecast:** Rainfall ranging between 0 and 15 mm is expected across the country. The predicted rainfall is within the range of Long-Term Mean (LTM) of the first dekad of July. Many parts of Musanze, Nyabihu, Rubavu, Nyamasheke and Rusizi Districts, northern parts of Burera District, western parts of Ngororero and Nyamagabe Districts as well as eastern parts of Rutsiro



District are expected to experience rainfall ranging between 10 and 15 mm. The remaining parts of Western and Northern Provinces, and Nyamagabe District, many parts of Kigali City, Nyagatare, Muhanga and Nyaruguru Districts, western parts of Gatsibo, Rwamagana, Ruhango, Nyanza and Huye Districts as well as northern parts of Kamonyi District are expected to experience rainfall ranging between 5 and 10 mm. The remaining parts of the country are expected to experience rainfall below 5 mm.

- 4. Wind forecast:** Moderate to strong wind speed, ranging from 4 m/s to 10 m/s, is expected across the country. Strong wind, ranging from 8 m/s to 10 m/s (orange colour), is expected in northern parts of Burera, Rubavu and Gicumbi Districts, central parts of Kirehe District, a small portion of western parts of Gatsibo, Rutsiro, Karongi, Nyamasheke and Rusizi Districts. Moderate to strong wind, ranging from 6 m/s to 8 m/s (yellow colour), is expected in Nyagatare District, many parts of Kirehe, Gatsibo, Burera, Rubavu, Rutsiro, Karongi, Nyamasheke and Rusizi Districts, eastern parts of Ngoma District, northern and southern parts of Kayanza District, central parts of Gicumbi District, northern parts of Musanze District as well as western parts of Nyabihu, Ngororero and Nyamagabe Districts. The remaining parts of the country are expected to experience moderate wind speed ranging from 4 m/s to 6 m/s (Green colour).
