



Weather forecast valid between 1st and 10th June 2025

1. **Summary:** During the first dekad of June 2025 (1st to 10th), rainfall amount ranging between 0 and 50 mm is predicted across the country. The expected rainfall is in the range of Long-Term Mean (LTM). The LTM for the first dekad of June ranges from 0 mm to 50 mm. Rainy days are expected to vary between 2 and 5 days depending on the location. The expected temperature is also in the range of the Long-Term Mean. The daytime maximum temperatures will range between 16°C and 28°C, while night time minimum temperature is expected to range between 6°C and 16°C. Additionally, moderate to strong wind is expected to range from 4 m/s to 10 m/s across the country.
2. **Rainfall forecast:** Rainfall amounts ranging from 0 mm to 50 mm is in the range of Long-Term Mean (LTM) for the first dekad of June 2025 is expected across the country. The highest rainfall amount which will range from 40 mm to 50 mm is expected in northern parts of Nyabihu District, western parts of Musanze District and north-eastern parts of Rubavu District. Rainfall amount which will range from 30 mm to 40 mm, is expected in many parts of Nyabihu District, central parts of Musanze and Ngororero Districts, eastern parts of Rubavu and Nyamasheke Districts, western parts of Nyamagabe District, Southern parts of Karongi District as well as northern parts of Rusizi District. Rainfall amount ranging from 20 mm to 30 mm, is expected in Rutsiro District, remaining parts of Rusizi, Nyamasheke, Karongi and Rubavu Districts, western parts of Nyaruguru and Ngororero Districts as well as central parts of Nyamagabe, Ngororero, Nyabihu and Musanze Districts. Rainfall amount ranging from 10 mm to 20 mm, is expected in remaining parts of Nyamagabe, Musanze, Nyabihu Districts, central parts of Nyaruguru District, western parts of Nyanza, Ruhango, Muhanga and Gakenke Districts, north-western parts of Burera District. Remaining parts of the country are expected to receive rainfall amount ranging from 0mm to 10mm.
3. **Forecast of Wind Speed:** Moderate to strong wind speed, ranging from 4 m/s to 10 m/s, is expected across the country. Strong wind, ranging from 8 m/s to 10 m/s (indicated in orange), is expected in many parts of Karongi District, northern parts of Rusizi and Rubavu Districts, eastern and southern parts of Rutsiro District as well as south-western parts of Nyamasheke District. Moderate to strong wind, ranging from 6 m/s to 8 m/s (indicated in yellow), is expected in several parts of Gatsibo, Nyagatare, Gicumbi, Rubavu, Rutsiro, Karongi, Nyamasheke and Rusizi, western parts of Nyamagabe, Ngororero and Nyabihu Districts, eastern parts of Kirehe and Burera Districts and northern parts of Musanze, Burera and Kayonza Districts. The remaining parts of the country are expected to experience moderate wind speed ranging from 4 m/s to 6 m/s (indicated in green).
4. **Temperature forecast**
 - **Maximum temperature:** The highest maximum temperature, ranging from 26°C to 28°C, is expected in Bugesera District, Amayaga, several parts of Kigali City, western parts of Ngoma District, eastern parts of Nyagatare District, south-eastern parts of Kayonza District and Bugarama



plain. The lowest maximum temperature, ranging from 16°C to 18°C, is expected in several parts of Nyabihu and Musanze Districts.

- **Minimum temperature:** The lowest minimum temperature, ranging from 6°C to 8°C, is expected in many parts of Musanze, Nyabihu, Ngororero, Nyamagabe and Nyaruguru Districts, north-eastern parts of Rutsiro District, south-eastern parts of Rubavu and Nyamasheke Districts and eastern parts of Rusizi District. On the other hand, the highest minimum temperature, ranging from 14°C to 16°C, is expected in eastern parts of Gatsibo and Kayanza Districts, south-eastern parts of Nyagatare District as well as north-eastern parts of Kirehe District.
